BISHOPSTONE PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of the Parish Council took place on Thursday 10th November. Details are in the full minutes of the meeting which are available on the village website (www.bishopstone-salisbury.co.uk). The main items considered were:

- Wiltshire Council's Community Area Transport Group had turned down the request for a pavement to be constructed along the south side of the High Road between Meadow View and the entrance to Whitlock Rise on grounds of cost. Given the width of the verge at this point they had suggested that the Parish Council might consider providing a less formal footpath for pedestrians to use that did not run immediately alongside the road. It was agreed to investigate the cost of providing a path with a gravel, or similar, surface along this section of verge.
- Arrangements have been made for a speaker from the South West Ambulance Service to attend the Parish Council meeting in January to give a presentation on the provision of Public Access Heart Defibrillators and on the support for their provision available from SWAS.
- Residents of Whitlock Rise confirmed that they had received advice from BT Openreach that, because of the distance from the "green box' that serves them, a high speed broadband service would be difficult to achieve. It was agreed to check speeds with others at the geographical extremes of the village to see how widespread this problem is.
- All the responses received by the Parish Council to its consultation on the proposal to erect a mobile phone mast on Netton Farm had been in favour. As a result the Parish Council had submitted comments to the developers strongly supporting this proposal. There would be a second round of consultation with the Parish Council when the planning application is submitted, which was expected to be during November/December.
- Following the extensive consultation in the village, it was agreed to site a bench to commemorate the Queen's 90th Birthday, and the longest reign by an English monarch, where the path from The Alley meets Bridge Road. It was also agreed to purchase a bench made of recycled materials.
- Wiltshire Council had consulted the Parish Council on BT's programme for removing public telephone kiosks throughout the county. The rise in the use of mobile phones and the internet means that public kiosks are now little used. BT's figures show that the kiosk opposite Pitts Lane was used just 8 times in the 12 months to October. It was agreed to respond by reference to the fact that mobile phone coverage in the village is currently poor and that the removal of the kiosk service should be delayed until after the proposed new mobile mast is approved and operational. Thereafter it would be open to the Parish Council to consider whether the kiosk structure should be retained, once the phone has been removed, for some alternative use.
- In a discussion about the Parish Council's finances, it was agreed to set the precept (the share of Council Tax the Parish Council receives from Wiltshire Council) for 2017/18 at a level that would increase income by approximately £900. This would result in an increase in that part of Council Tax attributable to the Parish Council of just over £3 a year for a Band D property.
- Cllr Brutton reported that he had begun discussions with others about how to implement the "Area Helpers" proposals in the Bishopstone Plan.

The next meeting of the Council will be on Thursday 12th January 2017 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall. All are welcome to attend.



Above all to Sarah and Sally for preparing the church and Richard for the wonderful organ music to accompany the hymns. Thank you all, and what a Team to make the occasion really great.

Our thanks also to the White Hart for the wonderful curry spread afterwards. About 45 of us enjoyed the company and the atmosphere in the pub, for which we thank Zara and Tom and their team for the day. Congratulations to them all for making it such fun and so memorable.

Finally, my sincere thanks to all the Poppy Appeal Collectors for their inestimable efforts on behalf of the Royal Brit-

ish Legion this year. We have opened and counted all the collecting tins and so far, have collected about £840 including gift aid. We look forward to something from the Church collection soon! The final sum will be announced in the January edition of STaB. Well done to the collectors for being so persistent and encouraging, and for the givers for being so generous.

Thank you to all the village, on behalf of the RBL. Your gifts will be so very well received by them, and will bring such comfort to old veterans, young military families in difficulties and to young and old soldiers, sailors and airmen/women either serving or undergoing rehabilitation or recovery at home. We can never understand some of their problems, but the RBL does and the RBL can often help. As another company says: 'Every Little Helps', and it certainly does to the RBL and the armed forces community.

Well done to all those who helped to organise this year's Remembrance, and to all those who gave cash or time.








The Menin Gate Memorial at Ypres, Belgium Some of our fallen are remembered in France and in Belgium, still there 100 years later.

The Chalke Valley Link Scheme exists to provide good neighbor support with transport and other practical help for all residents living in the Valley. Help provided includes transport to a doctor's or hospital appointment, collecting prescriptions or a run to the Post Office. Other assistance could include support with minor household chores, changing library books, or visiting those living on their own.

The Scheme is a Registered Charity and has served the Valley since 1996. It was presented with The Queen's Award for Voluntary Service in 2006. This award can be seen in the Broad Chalke Surgery waiting room.

A dedicated team of more than 90 drivers/good neighbor volunteers enable the Scheme to fulfil its role. Over 900 journeys were undertaken last year. Although all the team are volunteers, there are inevitable standing charges to the Link Scheme for insurance, telephone, mileage claims etc.

There is no set charge for those using the service, donations being voluntary. So the Link Scheme is most appreciative in this generous sponsorship from The Bishopstone Village Christmas Party.




