#### LEARN TO RING BELLS NEW RECRUITS NEEDED TO KEEP THIS ANCIENT ART GOING!

#### **Church Bells**

Church bells are the biggest and loudest musical instruments. Hidden away in church towers, they have been part of the rhythm and sound of village life for over a thousand years. Since Norman times church bells have been rung to mark the beginning and end of the working day, to tell the time and to warn people of invasion during times of national emergency, for church and saints days, for civic and national celebrations and for enjoyment and fun. Over 3000 bells that were rung in medieval times are still rung today. Near us Broad Chalke's oldest bell dates from 1370, Dinton from 1350 and the oldest bell in England, dating from 1260, is at West Tytherly.

### Could I be a ringer?

Yes - you could! Bell Ringing is great fun and ringers are welcomed to ring in towers all over the country and beyond. You don't need to be strong or an experienced musician. To be a good ringer you need to be prepared to work in a team, to practice and to make a firm commitment to ring for services and occasions such as village events, weddings, and national occasions after you have been taught. It is very inexpensive, suitable for anyone aged 10 to 100, and if you can coordinate enough to ride a bicycle you can learn to ring a bell.

### How can I find out more?

We are running a learn to ring course at All Saints Church Broad Chalke from June 17<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> The commitment is 2 hours each day on Saturday and Sunday 17/18 (2-4pm) followed by 1 hour each weekday (6.30 pm on Monday, 7.00pm Tuesday – Friday) and completing with 2 hours on Saturday 3-5pm). We hope that at the end of this week you will be able to ring a bell independently and be ready to join with other ringers to develop your ringing skills. The cost is £20 per person.

As spring rushes past, The Village Hall has been busy as usual.

Moviola film "A Street Cat Named Bob" was popular, especially with cat lovers, and also thought-provoking concerning the lives of young people who drop out of society. Magic Lantern's "Sean the Sheep" short films were very funny as was occasionally (unintentionally) the exciting main film of the evening "39 Steps", which had some extraordinary film studio scenery and special effects. Alfred Hitchcock's techniques exponentially improved over the years, but this was a classic film of its time and fun to watch. The April Village Lunch, last of the season, was an excellent buffet, with some wonderful salads and puddings volunteered by regular attenders. Lunch was followed by Becky Twigg giving a talk on "Bee City", a peaceful garden environment that she has created with help from the Council and volunteers in the old churchyard area near the mini roundabout at the east end of Churchfields Road. It is open to the public on Sundays from 12-4pm.

Rural Arts performers Kathryn Roberts and Sean Lakeman drew a very large audience from all over the area, including the parents of five children from Coombe Bissett School who participated on stage as the chorus for a song about a lonely whale. The children got a huge round of applause, and, like the rest of the audience, thoroughly enjoyed the programme of traditional and original folk songs performed by the talented and entertaining duo.

Coffee mornings, Needles and Pins, the Baby and Toddler Group and Photography continue

happily and, following the brilliant First Aid Course on Saturday 25th March, a group of 10 village residents and others are now qualified first aiders. There was also a defibrillator demonstration, (not on a real body) which explained a lot of the things you always wanted to know about defibrillators. We hope we never will have need to use the one that is being planned for our village, but having one available on the outside wall of the village hall could be a life-saver one day for someone. So, we hope everyone had an enjoyable, and memorable Easter!


