BISHOPSTONE PARISH COUNCIL

The next meeting of the Parish Council will be at 7.30pm on Thursday 8th May 2014 in the Village Hall. All are welcome to attend. Wiltshire Council Housing Officers have been invited to the meeting to discuss next steps following the Housing Needs Survey.

Latest News:

At the Parish Council's request, Wiltshire Council has cleared and resurfaced the car park in Whitlock Rise so it is now fully available for parking by residents. We will wait to see how resilient the new surface is to wear and bad weather!

The road drain by the pedestrian crossing near The White Hart has been replaced. Hopefully the large puddle that formed there in rainy weather will be a thing of the past.

Two meetings have been held with Drainage Engineers from Wiltshire Council about what can be done to prevent recurrence of this winter's flooding in the village. Detailed plans are being produced for a new drain in Croucheston and a digger has cleared the ditches where the flood occurred in Faulston Lane. This should reduce the risk of flooding of the road in the future.

The lease has been signed between Wiltshire Council and the Parish Council in respect of the "Garden Extensions" in The Styles. The land has been cleared and Licenses for allotment use are being issued to four villagers.

By the time you read this:

Potholes in the roads should have been filled: those on the High Road to prepare for the Cycle Wiltshire Road Race on 4th May and those on the village roads on 30th April, when the Balfour Beatty team are spending a day working in the village.

Further resurfacing should have taken place of the footpath from Flamstone St to Croucheston. A new warning road sign should have been erected either side of the Flamstone Street junction with the High Road.

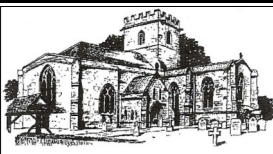
So we have much to rejoice! Above all we are all set free to live Christ’s Risen Life as we travel together through Eastertide! Alleluia!

R. N. L. I. LIFEBOATS (logo if possible)

A big Thank You to all the contributors to the annual House to House Collections to support the RNLI, and to all the collectors who worked so hard. The RNLI lifeboats are crewed by volunteers who deserve the best equipment we can give them. When older boats reach the end of their life they are replaced with new designs, built with modern materials, faster and with state of the art equipment. As an example, the Mersey class lifeboats are reaching the end of their 25 year working lives, and will be replaced by the Shannon class, 50% faster, making the RNLI's entire all-weather fleet capable of 25 knots. The cost of a Shannon is £2 million, and around 50 will enter service over the next 8-10 years – the first in Swanage.

The RNLI is financed entirely through voluntary contributions such as yours, and by legacies: there is no government money involved. Therefore your recent support is very much appreciated. The total collected in the RNLI's Wilton District was £6,400.82, with the Chalke Valley contributing £2,293.42 of this. Berwick St. John raised £162.46; Alvediston £143.35; Ebbesbourne Wake £167.52; Bowerchalke £433.86; Broad Chalke & Fifield Bavant £717.26; Bishopstone & Stratford Tony £303.41; Coombe Bissett £208.67, and Homington £156.63.

Our next fundraiser will be the Summer Garden Party in the gardens of Wilton House on the evening of Thursday 19th June: marquee, wine, canapes, jazz, raffle, presentation of awards, guest speaker (to be confirmed), all in the glorious surroundings of Wilton House. Did you know that last year more than 5000 people in Salisbury were given three days worth of emergency food supplies from the Trussell Trust's foodbank. These include 1,885 children, and the trust says the figures are "the tip of the iceberg of food poverty". Nationally, the number receiving help topped 900,000- a 163 per cent rise on the year before. These figures don't include those helped by other emergency food providers, those living in towns where there is no food bank, people who are too ashamed to seek help or the large number of people who are only just coping by eating less and buying cheap food.

There is still a great need in our area and we thank you for helping in our small way. Last month the village total was 37kgs. Please keep the donations coming in. People are so very grateful when they receive their box of food, so let us all help make someone's life that much better for a few days.
