BISHOPSTONE PARISH COUNCIL

The minutes of the Parish Council meeting which took place on Thursday 13th July 2017 are available on the village website (<u>www.bishopstone-salisbury.co.uk</u>). The main items discussed were:

- **High Road Footpath.** It was reported that some progress has been made with the proposal to provide a footpath along the verge of the High Road between Meadow View and Whitlock Rise. Discussions had been held with Wiltshire Highways Engineers, a specification drawn up and quotations for the cost of the work would now be sought.
- **Speed Indicator Device**. The South West Area Board of Wiltshire Council has announced that it is to make 50% grant funding available to enable groups of parish councils to purchase and operate Speed Indicator Devices in their area. It was agreed that this would be a useful back-up to the Community Speed Watch team in encouraging observance of the speed limit on the High Road. Discussions had been held with Broad Chalke and Bowerchalke Parish Councils about forming a consortium to own and operate a SID. Consideration was given at the meeting to a number of SID models and a preferred choice selected. Subject to confirmation from the other two councils it was agreed to make a bid to the SWWAB for funding.
- Parish Council Grants. A request for a grant had been submitted by the Bishopstone Mothers and Toddlers Group to help them meet the cost of Village Hall hire. It was agreed to provide a grant of £200 for 2017/18. It was also agreed to make grants to the PCC (churchyard maintenance and STaB), the Village Hall and the Chalke Valley Sports Centre. It was felt that more attention should be drawn to the wide range of sport and recreation facilities available to Bishopstone residents at the Chalke Valley Sports Centre. These include facilities for tennis, football, cricket, table tennis, short mat bowling, pilates, yoga and dance. For more information go to www.chalkevalleysportscentre.co.uk.

Fencing. It was agreed to seek quotes for the replacement of the fence on the west side of the Recreation Field.

- **Garden Extensions.** It was suggested that a reminder should be included in this STaB report that planning permission is required for the extension of domestic gardens into adjoining agricultural land. Anybody who has done this, or is considering doing it, should make the necessary application to Wiltshire Council.
- **Faulston Barns.** An "open day" for the village, with refreshments, was held on 19th August by the developers of Faulston Barns to thank villagers for putting up with any disruption during the construction phase.
- **Croucheston Mill.** The owners of Croucheston Mill, Mole Valley Farmers, wish to discuss with the Parish Council options for the future redevelopment of the site. It was agreed to invite representatives of the company to attend the meeting of the Parish Council in September for an initial discussion.

The next meeting of the Council will be on Thursday 14th September 2017 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall. The agenda for the meeting will be available on the village website (<u>www.bishopstone-salisbury.co.uk</u>) a week before the meeting. All are welcome to attend.

PEOPLE ASK: IS THERE A NEED FOR FOOD BANKS?

Contrary to many peoples conception, the Chalke Valley has a need greater than is obvious to the majority of people who continue to underestimate the very real need for social support amongst this rural community. If already on a very tight budget, even when in work ,this immediate need is often brought about by Benefit changes and delays, sudden unemployment and delayed wages, child holiday meals (as before they were being fed at school) or sickness. Did vou see the latest news about the food banks in Wales, they have run out of daily essentials due to the increase numbers seeking help. The welsh government have offered £500,000 to help relieve this situation there as they are so concerned. Here the Journal recently printed an article headlined "Primary Pupils Going Hungry" which included this passage:-"The charity said it's study showed how close to crisis many families were, and pledged extra help this summer. This will include a holiday club where trained volunteers will talk to struggling parents and offer support. Over a third of all the food distributed by food banks in our network consistently goes to children, but these new figures show 5 to 11 year-olds are more likely than other children to receive a food-bank's help. So please, continue your support and if you know of anyone in the valley who would benefit from help from the Trussell Trust then please contact us in complete confidentiality. The total for the last July was 21.8 and for August 24.4 kgs again thanks to those of you who continue to contribute to this worthy cause. At the moment they are again asking particularly for the following items to be included in your donation TINNED TOMATOES LONG LIFE FRUIT JUICES DRIED MILK INSTANT COFFEE

If you can include some of these amongst your normal donations it will help them enormously.

As usual donations can be left in the box in the church porch or at The Old Post Office, The Cross.
